ANDAMAN BOATYARD UNVEILS NEW BOAT DESIGN TO HELP FLOOD VICTIMS, PLANS AVAILABLE FREE

- **Boat created for maximum functionality and easy construction in 3 days at lowest possible cost**
- **PACE donates first 2 prototype boats to Ruamkatanyoo Foundation**

Andaman Boatyard, a leading Thai boat builder and Kipsan Beck, Chief Marketing Officer of PACE Development Corporation PLC. unveil a new design boat to help victims of the floods. The new, innovative construction is very simple with a boat taking only 3 days to build. The boat is very stable, and may be powered by paddles or an engine, capable of carrying 8-12 people at one time.

PACE Development has donated the first two prototype boats already built (value 150,000b) to the Ruamkatanyoo Foundation, presented on November 11 to Mr Somsak Palawann, Foundation Manager. Boats will be used to deliver relief supplies to families stranded in flooded areas.

Andaman Boatyard and Kipsan Beck will provide free sets of plans to individuals and non profit organisations wishing to construct their own boats. There are two sizes, approximately 8 X 16 feet, and 6 X 12 feet, and the design is easily scaleable to other sizes. People can construct the boats themselves using readily available materials and tools. Alternatively, Andaman Boatyard can also provide precut kits or completed boats at a reasonable price.
